As Director of the Cartersville Downtown Development Authority and Main Street Program I would like to thank you for participating in the story of our downtown community, and I would like to officially welcome you to the 6th Annual Bluegrass and Folk Festival. ## EDGAR LOUDERMILK BAND *featuring Jeff Autry*

Edgar Loudermilk's signature voice, bass skills, and songwriting are a family tradition for this Louvin Brothers' descendant. Having experienced a long tenure of performing, including several industry awards, with IIIrd Tyme Out, Rhonda Vincent, and Marty Raybon, in 2015 he stepped out forming his own band with the highly acclaimed guitarist, Jeff Autry. Edgar's band has released two projects, with the most recent, "Georgia Maple" debuting at #4 on the Billboard charts (July, 2016). The Pinecastle Records recording artist, Edgar Loudermilk Band, featuring Jeff Autry, have once again been in the studio and have a 2018 album release on the immediate horizon. Jeff Autry, long admired for his guitar skills, toured 14 years internationally with the John Cowan Band. In addition, he's performed and toured with Sam Bush, Bela Fleck, Tim O'Brien, Peter Rowan, the Lynn Morris Band, Yonder Mountain String Band, and the Travelin' McCourys. Rounding out the group are Zack Autry (mandolin/harmony vocals), Curtis Bumgarner (banjo), and Dylan Armour (resonator guitar). 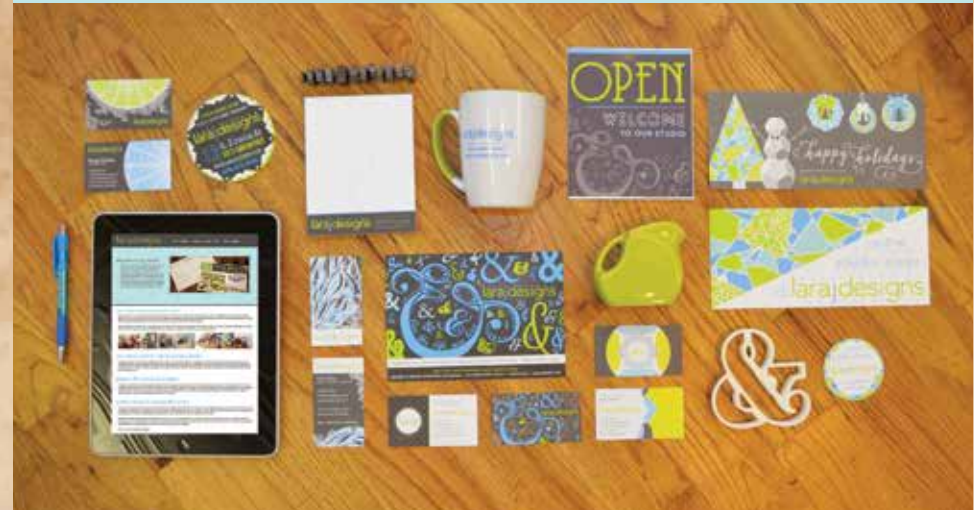
